- Every five minutes a child dies of violence
- Approximately one billion children worldwide have experienced physical, sexual or psychological violence in the past year

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) make an explicit commitment to ending violence against children, in all its forms and UN Member States commit to **end abuse, exploitation, trafficking, torture and all forms of violence against children by 2030.**

Left unchecked, the cumulative effects of violence undermine investments made in areas such as education, health and child well-being, making the prevention of violence critical to SDG achievement.

The Global Partnership to End Violence Against Children will work with partners across sectors with governments, the 'UN family', civil society, the private sector, foundations, researchers and academics, and children themselves to build political will, promote solutions, accelerate action and strengthen collaboration.

Goal 1: BUILD POLITICAL WILL

- 1.1** All countries commit to action to end violence against all children.
- 1.2** Violence against children and the actions needed to prevent them is part of national, regional and global discourse.
- 1.3** All countries see an increase in finances put towards ending violence and exploitation in all settings.

Goal 2: ACCELERATE ACTION

- 2.1** All countries adopt national legislation, policies and programmes to protect children from violence and exploitation, including online violence.
- 2.2** Pathfinder countries provide increased access for children to comprehensive, coordinated and multi-sectoral services.
- 2.3** Children affected by violence, including those in conflict settings and on the move, can access child centered services and programs.

Goal 3: STRENGTHEN COLLABORATION

- 3.1** Support platforms for sustained transnational action and learning.
- 3.2** Serve as the global forum to facilitate and accelerate learning and mutual accountability, make recommendations for standard setting and report on progress.
- 3.3** Generate and disseminate knowledge, evidence and data.
